Booking Terms and Cancellation Policy



Booking and Payment

1. Once your booking has been submitted and acknowledged by email from FT TSA your place on the course is confirmed;
2. Following acknowledgement by FT TSA, you are required to pay the course attendance fee or cancellation fee;
3. Course fees are payable in advance of the course date. FT TSA will invoice you for the full amount upon confirmation of your booking;
4. Payment must be made in full within 30 days from the date of the invoice. FT TSA reserves the right to charge interest at 3% on invoices which remain unpaid after this period;
5. FT TSA reserves the right to change and offer an alternative for any course date, time, venue or speaker;
6. Half-day course fees include light refreshments; full-day course fees include refreshments and lunch;
7. Delegates are required to bring photo ID to any course run on school premises. Access may be refused if photo ID can not be presented on arrival;
8. All delegates must supply a valid email & confirmation of booking to allow us to issue certificates on completion of any course.

Cancellation and Substitution

9. Notice of cancellation must be sent by email to enquiries@forwardtogethertsa.co.uk;
10. Where no cancellation notice is received by FT TSA no refund will be given for non attendance; where payment has not been made by the date of the course, the full amount invoiced remains payable and subject to FT TSA's booking terms and conditions;
11. Cancellation of a confirmed booking will incur a cancellation fee at 50% of the course fee. Where notice of cancellation is received 14 days or fewer prior to the date of the course, no refund will be made and the full course fee remains payable to FT TSA;
12. Delegates may be substituted at no additional charge;
13. If FT TSA cancels a course for any reason and your booking has been confirmed and paid for in full, you will be offered a place on the next available and suitable FT TSA course.
